DBC Learn to Sail Program

KEY Benefits of the DBC program are:

- ? One of the longest running summer sessions (April 8–July 28) lasting 17 weeks allows for the ability to miss some classes, and then catch up.

Class Description

Novice Sailing Program

DBC is proud to jointly offer with Edison Boat Club (EBC) an entry-level sailing class for persons with little or no experience. It is held at the EBC clubhouse located on the Detroit River at 100 Lycaste, Detroit. The course is designed to be an entertaining and simple introduction to sailing and water safety. Each sailor will learn the basics of sailing: parts of the boat, rigging (set-up) sails, steering the boat, leaving & returning to the dock under sail, and water safety. Students are also introduced to basic racing, usually racing with their fellow students, as well as having opportunities to participate in longer races against other clubs on Lake St. Clair and Detroit River as the class progresses.

This is a hands-on, get-wet (from bow spray, not capsizes) and have-a-lot of fun type of class. This course is designed to build skills and confidence through time on the water, chats on shore, and focus on fundamentals of sailing, safety and boat handling. Full Tuition for the Beginner Class is \$355.

Requirements

Sailors need to be at least 12 years old. They must weigh at least 80 lbs and feel comfortable around the water. Sailors need to be on time. All participants must wear a proper fitting life jacket at all times on the docks and boats! If you do not own a life jacket, one can be provided for you! Shoes are required to be worn at all times on the docks! Water-socks are recommended. *As guests of EBC All participants must behave in a respectful manner on the grounds and in the water. This is an instructional program, to teach the fundamentals of sailing. We reserve the right to dismiss any student if they cannot respect the basic rules of the club and/or the program. **Please note: There is a 10 mph speed limit on the property that must be obeyed.***

Recommended:

Bring and wear sun block, sunglasses & hat with retaining straps and towel.
